Grand Reserva Chardonnay, Shabo, Odessa District 1300

Mellow yellow champagne with a golden shade, ripe fruits and a touch of barrel flavor. Grand Reserva Chardonnay is fresh, elegant and alluring.

Due to the fact that the average annual temperature has risen and autumn cold comes later, winemakers frequently produce full-bodied and extractive wines in the South of the country.

Pino Noir, Winery of Duke P. N. Trubetskoy 1200

BOURGOGNE /

Burgundy is the birthplace of Chardonnay. Some of the best white wines in the world come from this region and there are very little to no competitors to these wines.

Chablis Domaine du Colombier 1500

Mild yellow mineral wine with fruity apple flavor and a very balanced taste. Perfect for aperitives and clam dishes.

Chablis 2017, W. Fevre 1800

Refreshing light yellow wine with a fruity, mineral and metallic taste. The classic version of Chablis.

Chablis Premier Cru Mont de Milieu 2014 J. Drouhin 3800

Bright yellow wine with a citrus and white flower flavor. Fresh and complex wine with an intense, harmonious and full-bodied taste.

Chassagne-Montrachet 2016, Ch. de la Maltroye 4000

Great wine with a taste of grilled toasts, aged cheese, almonds and wood. A well-structured, strong and open wine.

Puligny-Montrachet Premier Cru Folatieres 2015, J. Drouhin 7000

Golden-hued wine with a delightful flavor of apples, peaches and butter. Deep, full-bodied and pleasant, Puligny-Montrachet Premier Cru Folatieres has good structure and an excellent balance.

VAL DE LOIRE /

The Loire Valley is the birthplace of the second most popular grape variety — Sauvignon. This region boasts a broad assortment of wines, yet, all of them are united by their lightness. The most famous wine of the region is Sancerre and Pouilly, which is fresh, sharp and crispy.

Pouilly-Fume La Chante des Vignes, Joseph Mellot 4100

Pale yellow with golden glares, the wine has a complex aroma of exotic fruits, grapefruit and minerals. Lively and fresh in taste with a strong aromatic durability.

Volnay 2009, Marc Rossignol 2400

Splendid silky Pinot Noir with a smooth texture and delightfully strong balance.

Chassagne Montrachet Clos du Chateau 2013, Chateau de la Maltroye 3900

A great wine with a menthol taste carrying hints of spices and flowers. Sweet in the beginning, then more moderate. The wine has a dry and strict aftertaste.

Nuits-Saint-Gerges 2014, J. Drouhin 4900

Deep, powerful and elegant wine with notes of cherry and blackberry, accompanied by the hints of cedar wood. Nuits-Saint-Gerges has a perfect balance between structure and softness with a long-lasting aftertaste of spices and fruit syrups.

BORDEAUX /

Bordeaux is the greatest wine region of the world. It is the birthplace of the most popular red grape varieties – cabernet sauvignon and merlot. Nowhere else in the world you can find as many quality wines produced as in Bordeaux.

Medoc Clarendelle 2014, Clarence Dillon 2000

Gorgeous wine with chocolate, spices, cedar and underbrush. Medoc Clarendelle is a complex, yet fine wine with a medium body and soft tannins. The wine has a fresh and savory aftertaste.

Chateau Potensac Cru Bourgeois 2014 2900

A quality wine with black berries, cherries and plums, underlined by a cedar note. The wine has a soft tannins taste with an elegant aftertaste.

Chateau Poujeaux 2009 5200

Deep purple-hued wine with a delicate smokiness, blueberries and raspberries.

Le Dragon de Quintus 2013 2700

Bright red, almost crimson-like colored wine with a touch of oak and floral notes.

Le Dragon de Quintus has an ethereal, smooth and full-bodied taste. Pleasant and alluring wine that will provide immediate pleasure.

VAL DE RHONE /

The most virile and thrilling wines are produced in this sunny and vast region of France.

Crozec-Hermitage Petite Ruche 2015, M.Chapoutier 1500

Intensively red wine with violet reflections and a rounded fresh taste of red berries.

The aftertaste has a fruity and mildly spicy shade.

SUDTRIDOL /

Despite being the northernmost winemaking Italian region, it is remarkably strong. The most authentic white wines of Italy are produced here.

Pinot Grigio 2017, Eppan 1400

Bright golden-hued wine with wildflowers, tropical fruits with a mellow mineral note. Pinot Grigio is balanced with a pleasant aftertaste.

Riesling, Falkenstein 2200

Riesling has a strict mineral note and fruity shades in the taste with an enduring delicate aftertaste.

Chardonnay St-Valentin, Eppan 2400

A full-bodied charismatic wine with a grilled toast, nutty and vanilla taste. Chardonnay St-Valentin has mouthfeel of exotic fruits and butter, as well as vanilla and wood with an enduring aftertaste.

Gewurztraminer St-Valentin, Eppan 2400

One of the richest and deepest fragrances containing rose and various spices. Gewurztraminer St-Valentin has an incredibly diverse flavor and is very popular among women.

FRIULI /

This is the only region in Italy that specializes strictly on white wines. Some of the best white wines that reflect a character of a single variety come from here. Fragrant and invigorating, rarely barrel aged.

Sauvignon Ronco Del Cero, Venica&Venica 2200

Wild, intensive and gnarly aroma of this wine is hard to confuse with something else. Sauvignon Ronco Del Cero has a deep taste of fruit puree with some honey notes.

Malvazia, Ronco Del Gelso 1900

Characterized with ripe fruits, star anise and sea breeze, Malvazia has a long, ripe and slightly spicy body with an intense aftertaste.

PIEDMONT /

The region is known for the most felicitous vineyards of Italy. Local wines are distinguished by their power, wealth and maturity.

Gavi Masera, Stefano Massone 1500

An exotic lollipop wine with a gentle, pleasant taste and a smooth texture.

Gavi dei Gavi, La Scolca 2400

Mellow yellow-hued wine with a taste of fruits and wildflowers. Gavi dei Gavi is a strong wine with a flint accent and a slight nutty aftertaste.

VENETO /

Veneto is the most productive winemaking region of Italy, but only a handful of selected wines deserve attention.

Raudi Garganega, Domini Veneti 1000

Mellow yellow-hued wine with a very moderate fruity and herbal taste. Raudi Garganega Domini Veneti is refreshing and tropical underlined by a mineral touch.

Soave Classico, Pieropan 1200

Deep yellow wine with a golden hue, Soave Classico has the taste of a melon, mango, nuts and spices. Structured and fruity, the wine has a great accentuating acidity.

SICILY /

This part of Italy proved the stereotype wrong that red wine requires a hot climate, while white — a cool one. The biggest success and breakthrough Sicily reached specifically with white wines.

Lighea Donnafugata 1600

White wine of a flashing beige-like yellow color with a taste of orange flowers and bergamot zest. Lighea Donnafugata is fresh and has a slight mineral note.

La Fuga Donnafugata 1600

Mellow yellow wine with a tropical, pineapple, peach and flower taste. La Fuga Donnafugata is harmonious with pleasant acidity and ripe fruits flavor.

SARDINIA /

Sardinia is the largest Italian island, however, judging by grape varieties and wine stylistic it is more Spanish than Italian. The footprint of Aragon, the Spanish autonomous community, has not yet faded.

Bright straw-colored wine with fragrant herbs, citrus and wild flowers. Encompassing a complete flavor, Vermentino Montecoro has an enduring sea mineral aftertaste.

Crafty Italians came up with a technique called grape drying to get one of the finest wines from one of the most productive regions of Italy.

Valpolicella Superiore, Zenato 1000

Dark ruby-colored wine with a berry jam, spices and tar. Smooth and structured, Valpolicella Superiore has a taste of dark ripe berries, dried fruit and chocolate.

Amarone Valpolicella Classico, Zenato 3200

Pomegranate-red wine with a heady bouquet of dried black cherries, currant, truffles, chocolate fudge and tar. Silky and complex, Amarone Valpolicella Classico has a lasting savory aftertaste.

PIEDMONT /

Some of the richest and charismatic wines of Italy come from Piedmont.

Pinot Nero 2014, Vajra 2400

Ruby-hued wine with pure berries, underbrush bits and dried herbs. Pinot Nero 2014 has a medium-bodied taste with harmonious tannin structure and acidity – an aristocratic wine with a great potential.

Barbaresco Nubiola, Pelissero 2500

Burgundy-colored wine with red fruits and medicinal plants. Barbaresco Nubiola has a soft, astringent taste and leaves a sweet feeling behind.

Chianti Classico, Castellare di Castellina

Ruby red wine with the flavor of flowers and berries. Chianti Classico has just the right amount of dryness with a pleasant tannin aftertaste.

Varvara 2016, Castello di Bolgheri

2000

Dark pomegranate-hued wine with underbrush and wild berries, tobacco leaves and cedar. Strong yet elegant, Varvara 2016 has a taste of velvety tannins and a long aftertaste

Cifra 2017, Duemani

2700

Bright pomegranate-hued wine with fragrant red berries, delicate tannins, notes of salt and fresh grass. Lively and welcoming, Cifra 2017 is quite gentle and soft.

Brunello di Montalcino 2013, La Fiorita

3800

Dark in color and fresh in taste, Brunello di Montalcino 2013 has a flavor of cherries, flowers, black pepper and tobacco leaf. The wine is slightly earthy with a well imbued tannin. Powerful and full-bodied, this wine has character and soul.

Camalaione 2013, Le Cinciole

3800

Dark pomegranate-hued wine made with black wild berries, cherry marmalade, tobacco leaf and cedar. Strong in texture with an excellent balance, Camalaione 2013 has an unforgettable taste.

Altrovino 2014, Duemani

4000

Dark red wine with underbrush, tar, balsamic notes and wild berries. Altrovino 2014 is textured, viscous and fleshy with soft fruity tannins, chocolate and spices.

MARCHE /

Marche is a young, fashionable and an up-and-coming region in Italy.

Kurni 2015, Oasi degli Angeli

7500

Strong wine of pomegranate color with red berries, spices and dried fruits. Kurni 2015 has a rich taste of berry jam, leather, fruit syrup, ripe tannins and a sweet aftertaste.

SICILY /

Sicily made its name by virtue of great white wines, but the diversity of its soils and local grape varieties launched the production of quality wines from local red varieties.

Sedara Donnafugata

Ruby red wine made with black wild berries with black pepper hints. Sedara Donnafugata has a good structure, soft tannins and a pleasant freshness.

SARDINIA /

Wines from Sardinia, both white and most of red, are primarily accompanied by local cuisine, which is based on sea food dishes.

Dimonius 2012, Sella & Mosca

1900

Ruby red wine with ripe cherry, plum, underbrush and nutmeg. Dimonius 2012 has pleasant tannins, which harmonizes perfectly with balsamic notes and a fruity jam.

CATALONIA /

Catalonia is the region of Cava production with 95% of sparkling wine coming from there. It is also known for white dessert wine and full-bodied red wines made from both local and international grape varieties.

5 Fincas 2015, Castillo Parelada 1700

Deep cherry-hued wine with red berries and balsamic notes. Balanced and well structured, 5 Fincas 2015 has fresh tannins well integrated in its taste with a long spicy aftertaste and vivid character.

RIBERA DEL DUERO /

Tempranillo, the finest Spanish grape variety, reaches its fullest potential and vitality in Ribera Del Duero. Wines from this region embody the full power of “The Red King of Spain”.

Una Cepa 2014, Bodegas Valduero 2200

Dark cherry colored wine with ripe fruits, oak and leather. Well-structured and strong, Una Cepa 2014 has a flavor of candied fruits and spices.

Alenza Gran Reserva, Bodegas Condado de Haza 4000

Dark red wine with black grilled ripe fruits. Mellow structured with a mineral touch, Alenza Gran Reserva is flavorful and enduring.

GERMANY

MOSEL /

Wine from Mosel region is hard to confuse with anything else – they are fresh, tender, and soft. Women’s favorite delicacy.

Riesling Kabinett Erdener Treppchen, Dr. Loosen 1300

Golden straw-hued wine made with green apples, pears and meadow herbs. A refreshing wine with citrusy and herbal taste.

Austrian wines are surprisingly pure. Austrian style of winemaking is more reminiscent of Alsace than Germany. Since the climate is harsh and yield is low, the wine in Austria is much stronger than it is in Germany.

Gruener Veltliner Federspiel Terrassen, Domane Wachau 1200

Bright yellow with a green shade, the wine has a taste of green apples, meadow herbs and white pepper. Harmonic and juicy wine with a long-lasting aftertaste of fruits and spices.

Chardonnay 2017, Nikolaihof 2300

Straw yellow-hued wine with green highlights, Chardonnay 2017 has a flavor of tropical fruits, yellow apples and minerals. The wine is savory, elegant and exceptionally clear.

USA

OREGON /

Even though Oregon is not a leader in wine production in the U.S., it has a cool climate, which suits perfectly for Burgundian grape varieties.

Chardonnay Arthur, Drouhin 3300

Golden-hued wine with acacia blossom, pears, lychee and lemon custard. Chardonnay Arthur has fresh acidity with a mineral character, as well as notes of almond and creamy croutons.

Pinot Noir Arthur, Drouhin 3800

Ruby-hued wine with plums, cherries, candied fruits, sandalwood and oak hints. Pinot Noir Arthur has a flavor of dark fruits and spices with soft ripe tannins, which are perfectly integrated into its structure.

ARGENTINA

In fact, all of Argentina's vineyards are situated in Mendoza. Most prominent feature of this region is its elevated location of the vineyards. On average, vineyards are 1000 m above the sea, but there are some that reach over the 3000m mark. These fruit wines are intense and have a good balance.

Pinot Noir, Luigi Bosca 1300

Bright red-hued wine made with black fruits and spices. Clear and lively, Pinot Noir is passion-full and has an oaky aftertaste.

Syrah, Luigi Bosca 1400

Deep burgundy wine made with spicy leather, smoky notes and boiled fruits. Fresh, flavorful and tender, Syrah has solid tannins and a distinctive long aftertaste.

Reserva Malbec, Terazzas 1600

Brightly red with a purple hue, Reserva Mablec is made with black ripe cherry, plum, black pepper and chocolate. Juicy and sweet, the wine has delicate tannins, leather and sandalwood mouthfeel, as well as black ripe fruits in its aftertaste.

AUSTRALIA

Winemaking in Australia exists purely on trends with little to no traditions or preferences with wine export reaching the 70% mark. At the same time Australian Shiraz is one of the finest wines.

Shiraz Love Grass, d'Arenberg 1200

Spicy fruity wine with ripe berries, notes of black chocolate and pepper. Best served with stewed meat dishes

Lieu dit Malakoff Shiraz 2009, Dom. Terlato & Chapoutier 2200

Red pomegranate-hued wine with a taste of blueberries, currants, violet, mint and sun-roasted herbs. Soft with silky texture, Lieu dit Malakoff Shiraz 2009 has notes of herbs, spices and black ripe berries.

NEW ZEALAND

MARLBOROUGH /

When in 1980s, the very first Sauvignon in New Zealand was produced, it has become clear that for many years to come the demand will be much higher than the supply with only about 6,000 ha of vineyards.

Marlborough is a perfect place for Sauvignon – cool climate, high humidity and plenty of sun.

Sauvignon Blanc, Endless River

Sauvignon Blanc has a typical Marlborough flavor – citrusy and herbal with a fresh and mild taste.

Sauvignon Blanc, Cloudy Bay

1900

Mellow yellow-hued with a green shade, the wine has a typical gooseberry flavor with grapefruit, lime and green pepper aromas. This Sauvignon Blanc is pleasant, subtle and moderately dry.

MARLBOROUGH /

Pinot Noir has only recently taken a leading position on the Marlborough island.

The wine of this region is characterized as fragrant and tender.

Pinot Noir, Cloudy Bay

2300

A complex wine with dark berries, cherries, cinnamon, sweet leather and soft tobacco. Pinot Noir has a savory, rounded flavor with mild tannins and bright acidity, which adds class to this wine.

CHILE

Region's territory is divided into climatic zones with different soils. Local wines are characterized as inexpensive, simple and high-quality.

Carmenere Alpha, Montes

Deep ruby red wine with red berries, black pepper, black chocolate, vanilla and smoked plums. Carmenere Alpha is smooth with gentle rounded soft tannins and a long-lasting aftertaste.

Don Melchor, Concha y Toro

3700

Deep pomegranate colored wine with a flavor of small red fruits. Smooth and pleasant, Don Melchor is rich, full-bodied with a diverse fruit palette and a vivid aftertaste.
